FISH & WILDLIFE FREE HUNTER SAFETY EDUCATION

Local Game Wardens will be teaching a FREE, one-day, 8-hour hunter safety course on Sunday, March 22, 2020, 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM, at the Santa Cruz Harbor Public Meeting Room.

Students will receive training in firearms safety and handling, sportsmanship and ethics, wildlife management and conservation, archery, black powder, wildlife identification, game care, first aid, and survival as a requirement for obtaining a hunting licence.
